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## Fabric Requirements:

(Featured Fabrics are from Elizabeth's Studio Burst of Color collection)

| $\mathbf{6 6 3}$ Multi (Roses) | $1 / 2$ yard |

| $\mathbf{6 6 4}$ Multi (Tulips) | $1 / 3$ yard |
| $\mathbf{5 9 9}$ Multi (Succulents) | $3 / 4$ yard |
| $\mathbf{5 7 2}$ Lavender (Lavender) | $5 / 8$ yard |
| $\mathbf{5 6 1}$ Purple (Pansies) | $1 / 3$ yard |
| White Solid | $2-1 / 2$ yards |
| $\mathbf{5 6 1}$ Purple (Pansies) | $1 / 3$ yard for border |
| $\mathbf{6 6 3}$ Multi (Roses) | $1 / 2$ yard for binding |

Backing Fabric: 3-1/2 yards
Batting: for $54 \times 54$ " quilt

## Cutting:

663 Multi (Roses)

664 Multi (Tulips)

Cut (2) 6-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric) strips, cross cut into (9) 6-1/2" blocks.

Because this is a directional fabric, cut (4) 6-1/2" blocks ON THE DIAGONAL to keep Tulips upright in the quilt.


## Cutting:

599 Multi
(Succulents)

572 Lavender
(Lavender)

Cut (7) 2-3/8" x WOF strips, cross cut into (104) 2-3/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal to form (208) half-square triangles. $\square$

Cut (3) $3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, cross cut into (36) 3-7/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal to form (72) half-square triangles. $\square$

561 Purple (Pansies) Cut (2) 3-7/8" x WOF strips, cross cut into (16) 3-7/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal to form (32) half-square triangles. $\qquad$

First, cut (1) 18-1/8" x WOF strip, cut strip into (2) 18-1/8" squares. Cut squares twice on the diagonal to form (8) quarter-square side setting triangles.


Cut (1) 9-3/8" WOF, cross cut into (2) 9-3/8" squares, cut once on the diagonal to form (4) half-square corner setting triangles. $\square$

Cut (6) 2 " x WOF strips, cross cut into (104) 2" squares.

Cut (7) 2-3/8" x WOF strips, cross cut into (104) 2-3/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal to form (208) half-square triangles. $\square$

Cut (3) 4-1/4" X WOF strips, cross cut into (26) 4-1/4" squares, then cut twice diagonally to form (104) quarter square triangles.


561 Purple (Pansies) Cut (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border, set aside.

## Assemble the Star Point units:

## Make half-square triangles:



Sew together (1) 599 Multi (Succulents) 2-3/8" triangle and (1) White Solid $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to form a half-square triangle. Repeat to make a total of (104) half square triangle units.

Make the corner four-patch units:
 Use (104) 2" White Solid squares and (104) half-square units from above step to form four-patch corner unit. Make (52) corner units.

Make the star point sections:


Sew together (1) 4-1/4" White Solid quarter-square triangle and (2) 2-3/8" 599 Multi (Succulents) triangles to form first part of unit. Make (52) units.


Sew (2) 2-3/8" triangles White Solid to each side of unit, being sure to orient triangles correctly. Then add (1) 4-1/4" White Solid quarter-square triangle to the bottom of this unit.

Finally, add (2) 3-7/8" floral fabric (see below) half-square triangles to each side of the unit to complete the star point sections.

Make (16) 561 Purple (Pansies)


Make (36) 572 Lavender (Lavender)


## Complete the Flower Blocks:

## Assemble the Tulip blocks:

First Row: Sew together Succulent/White corner unit, one $\mathbf{5 6 1}$ Multi (Pansies) star point unit, and
(1) Succulent/White corner unit to form first row.

Maintain proper orientation of units.
Second row: Sew together (1) star point unit, (1) 6-1/2" square 664 Multi (Tulips) and (1) star point unit to form second row.


Sew together three rows to form complete Tulip block.

Make a total of (4) Tulip blocks, using 561 Multi (Pansies) star point units.


Assemble the Rose blocks:
Repeat above steps to make (9) Rose blocks, using 6-1/2" 663 Multi (Rose) centers and 572 Lavender (Lavender) star point units.


## Assembling the Quilt Top:

## Assemble the Rows:

Sew the blocks and 18-1/8" quarter-square setting triangles together into rows. Be sure that the Tulip blocks all point in one direction. (See diagram for placement of blocks).

## Complete the quilt top:

Sew the rows together, taking care not to stretch the edges. Add the 9-3/8" half-square corner triangles.


## FINISHING THE QUILT:

## Adding the border:

Sew together the 1-1/2" strips of 561 Purple (Pansies) to form one long strip.

Cut (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and add to sides of quilt top. Be careful not to stretch edges of the quilt top as you sew. Cut (2) 1-1/2" $\times 53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and add to top and bottom of quilt top.


## Prepare Backing:

Cut backing fabric in half across the width of the fabric, and sew together on long edges to form backing.

## Completing Quilt:

Layer quilt top, batting and backing.
Quilt as desired. Use 2-1/2" strips 561 Purple (Pansies) to bind quilt.
