

FABRICS: *Headin' Home* by Billy Jacobs for Elizabeth's Studio LLC

4705 Blue (Large panel)—2/3 yard (1 panel)
241 Sepia (Flowers)—5/8 yard
357 Gray (Woodgrain)—3/4 yard
357 Red (Woodgrain)—5/8 yard
357 Antique White (Woodgrain)—3/8 yard
Binding Fabric (357 Red Woodgrain)—3/8 yard
Backing fabric—for 50-1/2" x 43-1/2" quilt top
Batting for 50-1/2" x 43-1/2" quilt top

CUTTING DIRECTIONS:

4705 Panel: Fussy cut panel to measure 19-1/2" x 38-1/2", centering motifs

241 Sepia (Flowers): Cut (5) 2-1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips, cross cut into (70) 2-1/2" squares. Cut (2) 3-1/4" WOF strips, cross cut into (14) 3-1/4" squares.

357 Gray (Woodgrain): Cut (3) 3-1/4" x WOF strips, cross cut into (28) 3-1/4" squares. Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for first border, set aside.


357 Red (Woodgrain): Cut (2) 3-1/4" x WOF strip, cross cut into (14) 3-1/4" squares. Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for third border, set aside.

357 Antique White (Woodgrain): Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, set aside for outer border.

Binding Fabric—357 Red (Woodgrain): Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

MAKING THE STAR BLOCK:

Cut 3-1/4" squares sepia flowers, 3-1/4" squares gray woodgrain and 3-1/4" squares red woodgrain diagonally twice.



Piece together sepia flowers, gray woodgrain and red woodgrain triangles, using 1/4" seam allowance, to form (56) quarter square blocks. Maintain the direction of woodgrain, or let it be random.

Sew together the quarter square blocks and 2-1/2" sepia flowers squares to form (12) Star Blocks. Take care to maintain orientation of quarter square blocks. Sew together two rows of (6) Star blocks.

ASSEMBLING QUILT TOP:

First border (Gray Woodgrain): Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 19-1/2" and add to sides of panel. Sew (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips together to form one long strip, cut into (2) 42-1/2" strips and add to top and bottom of main panel.

Second border (pieced blocks): Add Star Block rows to top and bottom of panel.


Third border (Red Woodgrain): Add (2) 2-1/2" x 35-1/2" strips to sides of panel. Sew together (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips to form one long strip, cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" strips, add to top and bottom of main panel.

Fourth border (Antique White Woodgrain): Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 39-1/2" strips and add to sides of panel. Sew together (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips to form one long strip, cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips, add to top and bottom of panel.

FINISHING:

Layer with batting and backing fabric, quilt as desired. Use 2-1/2" binding strips to complete quilt.
