
# Packable Panda Quilt

FABRIC: Panda Bears by Howard Robinson for Elizabeth's Studio LLC

1230 Black (Pandas/Flowers)-1/3 yard

1330 Green (Bamboo)-2 yards

1329 Black (Pandas/Butterflies)-1-5/8 yard

1330 Green (Bamboo)-1/2 yard for binding

Batting: 41" x 50"

#### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

**1230 Black (Pandas/Flowers):** Cut (1) 10-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric) strip. **1330 Green (Bamboo):** Cut (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Cut (1) backing panel 41" wide by

**1330 Green (Bamboo):** Cut (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Cut (1) backing panel 41" wide by 50" long.

**1329 Black (Pandas/Butterflies):** Cut (1) 36" x WOF strip. Cut (1) 16-1/2" x WOF strip, cross cut into (2) 16-1/2" squares.

1330 Green (Bamboo): Cut (6) 2-1/2" X WOF strips for binding.

### **QUILT FRONT:**

Sew together: 10-1/2" x WOF **1230 Black (Pandas/Flowers)**, 4-1/2" x WOF **1330 Green (Bamboo)**, and 36" x WOF **1329 Black (Pandas/Butterflies)**. Be sure that all pandas are facing up. Trim width of panel to measure 41" wide x 50" long.



## FINISHING THE QUILT:

Layer the finished quilt top with 41" x 50" batting and 41" x 50" **1330 Green (Bamboo)** backing. Quilt as desired. Use reserved **1330 Green (Bamboo)** strips to bind quilt.

#### **ADDING POCKET:**

Using 1/4" seam allowance, sew together (2) 16-1/2" squares, leaving a 4" opening on the bottom edge for turning. Clip corners, turn. Center the pocket on the backing side of the quilt. Topstitch in place 1/8" from sides and bottom of pocket, leaving top edge open.



#### **FOLDING:**

From the front, fold both sides of the quilt towards the center, overlapping until even with the sides of the pocket. Fold the bottom of the quilt up even with the bottom of the pocket. Fold the top of the quilt down to form a square. Flip the square over, reach into the pocket and grasp the bottom of the pocket and the folded square. Turn the pocket inside out so that the folded quilt is inside the pocket.
