Fabrics: *Who Lives in the Woods* by Elizabeth's Studio LLC

723 Beige (panel)—2/3 yard 724 White (animals)—1/2 yard 728 Green (tonal)—1/3 yard 626 Black (dots)—1/2 yard Binding—728 Green (tonal))—1/2 yard Backing—1-7/8 yard Batting—for 36" x 51" quilt top

Cutting Directions:

723 Beige (panel): Trim panel to measure 23" wide by 38" high.

724 White (animals): Cut (3) 5-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric), cross cut into (15) 5-1/2" squares.

7**28 Green (tonal):** Cut (4) 1-3/4" x WOF, cross cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 38" and (2) 1-3/4" x 25-1/2" inner borders. Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF, set aside for binding.

626 Black (dots): Cut (3) 5-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric), cross cut into (15) 5-1/2" squares.

<u>First Border (green)</u>

Add 1-1/2" x 38" **728 Green (tonal)** strips to sides of center panel. Add 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" **728 Green (tonal)** strips to top and bottom of center panel.

Constructing Pieced Border

Side borders: Sew together (4) 5-1/2 squares **626 Black (dots)** and (4) 5-1/2" squares **724 White (animals)** to form side border. Be sure that the top block is White and that the animals are heads up! Repeat to make a second identical border. Sew to the sides of the quilt top.

Top Border: Sew together (4) 5-1/2" squares **626 Black (dots)** and (3) 5-1/2" **724 White** (animals) to form top border—border will begin and end with **626 Black (dots).** Be sure the animals are heads up.





Bottom border: Sew together (4) 5-1/2" squares **724 White** (animals) and (3) 5-1/2" squares **626 Black (dots)** to form border. Border will begin and end with **724 White (animals)**. Again, be sure animals are heads up. Sew in place at bottom of quilt top.



Finishing the Quilt:

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Use reserved 2-1/2" x WOF **728 Green (tonal)** strips to bind quilt. Side border Make 2
